

2018 SEC Academic Conference Student Poster Competition

<u>Summary</u>

Students will present posters highlighting research projects related to the conference theme: *Cyber Security: A Shared Responsibility*.

Poster Guidelines

- Due to space constraints, we must limit each institution to two posters.
- Each poster can have a maximum of one student presenter, two max per institution.
- Posters will be displayed alongside the corresponding institution's exhibit booth. (See page 3 for examples)
- Posters must be no more than four feet in width by three feet in height.
- Poster contents are to be designed for the general public to understand.
- Posters will be hung on drape; hooks will be provided.
- Poster font should be large enough to easily read from a distance of 2-3 feet.
- Illustrations (graphs, pictures, figures, tables) should be large enough for easy observation and contain brief captions, if appropriate.
- Posters should be displayed during the entire conference. Presenters will need to be with their posters during designated periods.
- Poster presenters should prepare a brief oral presentation of their poster and should be prepared to answer questions from conference attendees.

Judging and Awards

All of the participating posters and presentations will be judged by all conference attendees and professionals within the industry. Judging will be open the duration of the conference; however, receptions are scheduled for Sunday, April 8th from 3-5 p.m. and Monday, April 9th from 4-5:30 p.m. to encourage judging. Prizes will be awarded to first, second, and third place winners at the awards ceremony on Monday, April 9th at 5:30 p.m. at the Auburn Arena.

Participants will be provided with a sample judging evaluation sheet before the event.
